Stakes classes will be paid as a percentage (20%, 15%, 10% and 5%)

*Please note: If there are six or less entries in any regular stakes class, only first (1st) place will be paid 20% of the total entry fees.

RULES:

All equine activities are pursuant to PA Law, Act 93 of 2005

1. All riders must wear SEI approved helmets while mounted on a horse anywhere on the show grounds.
2. Borrowdale Acres Inc., Yellow Rose 4-H, NPHA, Luzerne County Fair and the show committee will not be held responsible for any loss or injury to any person, animal or property incurred on the show grounds.
3. The show committee reserves the right to make any adjustments necessary to make the show run in a more timely fashion.
4. The entire division must be entered to be eligible for a stake class.
5. A current negative coggins is required at the Secretary's stand and/or must be on the master coggins list.
6. All ponies that are showing in Children's Hunter Pony must be measured by the NPHA Steward or hold a permanent NPHA or USEF Measurement card.
7. All dogs must be on a leash.
8. The show will run in accordance with current NPHA and USEF rules.
9. **No exhibitors, trainers nor spectators will be permitted to speak directly to a judge(s) without making arrangements with the steward.**
10. NPHA is a participating series for The Colonial Classic ***In order to qualify for the 2019 Colonial Classic, you must be a member of a participating Local Horse Show Series. You then will accumulate points from 1/1/2019 – 8/14/2019. The top 3 riders from each division will be selected by their horse show series to show at the Colonial Classic.**
11. ***All ages are as of December 1 of the preceding year. Children are 17 years old and under.**
12. Beginner riders may not cross enter into any division at an above height.

***Stalls are available on a pre-paid, non-refundable basis for \$20.00 each. Stalls must be cleaned prior to leaving the grounds or you will be billed a \$25.00 surcharge per stall. For Stall Reservation Call: Donna Fine at 570-310-1641**

The horse show ring is 200 x 270 feet enclosed by vinyl fencing. The warm up area is sand.

Directions: From I-81: Take Exit 170B. Follow route 309 N for approximately 10 miles. Take route 415 N for approximately 3 miles. Turn left onto route 118 W. Make first left onto Yalick Road. Make first right into Gate B of the fairgrounds. Watch for signs

Each rider is responsible for knowing which classes they are eligible for and follow the rules accordingly.

Low Adult/Children's Hunter Horse Over Fences Stake Class Trophy Sponsored By: Borrowdale Acres

The Carole Malig and Jane Morris Challenge Trophy

The Challenge Trophy will be presented to the winner of the Pleasure Horse/Pony Division but will remain in the custody of Borrowdale Acres. Until such time a rider has won the trophy for 3 Consecutive years at which time the trophy will be retired and become the possession of that rider. The winner of the Challenge Trophy is entitled to possession of the trophy for a period of ten months from date of winning. At the expiration of 10 months, or two months prior to the next annual competition the winner will return the trophy to Borrowdale Acres. The winner is responsible for protection and care of the trophy while in his possession. The competition may demand return of trophy to Borrowdale Acres. Failure of an exhibitor to return the trophy constitutes a violation; the exhibitor who had possession of the trophy must pay to the competition the cost of replacing it with a trophy equally suitable and satisfactory to the Show Committee. If a Challenge Trophy is destroyed, stolen or lost and therefore cannot be returned, the exhibitor who had possession of the trophy must pay to the competition the cost of replacing it with a trophy equally suitable and satisfactory to the Show Committee. The conditions of the Challenge Trophy may not be changed without the consent of the trophy donor or his legal representative and of all who have qualified as past winners of the trophy.

Professional Division 2'6" Open to any adult professional. To be judged on the horse.

Jr. Equitation 14-17 / 13 & Under To be judged on position and overall ability and turnout. The over fence classes will be 2'3" for ponies and 2'6" for horses that can include roll backs, trot jumps, bending lines, and/or jumper style jumps.

Baby Green Hunter Horse 2'3" / Baby Green Hunter Pony 2' Open to any horse or pony in their first or second year of showing, to be judged on the horse or pony. Only children to ride ponies.

TB Hunter 2'3" – Open to all Thoroughbreds. To be judged on the horse.

Short Stirrup Hunter 1'9" To be judged on the horse/pony. Riders must be 10 years old and under. Jumps will not exceed 1'9". Riders may cross enter into other divisions where the jumps do not exceed 2'.

Short Stirrup Equitation Cross Rails To be judged on the position and overall ability and turnout. Riders must be 10 years old and under. Jumps will not exceed 1'9".

Beginner Equitation Cross Rails Open to children or adults only who are in their first or second year of showing. To be judged on position and overall ability and turnout. ***Only children will qualify for Colonials in this division.***

Long Stirrup Cross Rails Open to children 11 years and older and adult amateurs on horses or ponies. To be judged 50% on equitation and 50% on horse. ***Only adults will qualify for Colonials in this division.***

Mini Stirrup/Pre-Short Stirrup Open to riders, must be 8 years old and under. May cross enter into any other class where jumping is not permitted.
