Directions: From Interstate 80 E, take exit 236, Rt 487 N and then follow GPS. DO NOT TAKE follow GPS if traveling I-80 West, the roads are small with turns too sharp for trailers. Exit 236B, then follow GPS.

1. Entry fees \$20/ class, Stakes classes/ \$22, Marshal and Sterling \$35.
Stakes classes will pay back as percentages (20%, 15%, 10% and 5%). If there are six entries or less in any stake class, only first place will be paid; 20%.
2. Stall fee \$60/ weekend (includes 1 bag of shavings) additional bags can be purchased \$6/bag. Camper hookups- \$50.
3. Neither the horse show committee, Ridge Road, Keystone Horse Center or volunteers will be held responsible for damage, injury or loss of person, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the show grounds.
4. Classes for junior riders are limited to riders who have not reached their 19 th birthday prior to Dec 1, 2018.
5. All riders must wear an ASTM approved helmet when mounted.
6. The decision of the judge is final.
7. No martingales permitted in under saddle classes.
8. All fence heights are approximate.
9. There will be a \$40 fee for any non-negotiable checks.
10. Proof of negative coggins is required.
11. All dogs MUST be on a leash.
