Adult Hunter / Children's Hunter Horse 3' – Adult Hunter is open to any horse or pony ridden by an amateur adult. May not cross enter into Low Adult Hunter or Low Children's Hunter.

Adult Equitation 2'6" -Open to adults only. To be judged on position and overall ability and turnout. Can include roll backs, bending lines, and/or jumper style jumps. *Only adult amateur riders will qualify for Colonials*

Low Adult Hunter/Low Children's Hunter Horse 2'6" – Open to any horse ridden by an amateur adult or child. Adults may ride ponies. To be judged on the horse. May not cross enter into Adult Hunter or Children's Hunter.

Jr Equitation 14-17/ 13 & under- to be judged on position and overall ability and turnout. The over fences class will be 2'3" for ponies and 2'6" for horses that can include roll backs, trot jumps, bending lines, and/or jumper style jumps.

****Cross rail Schooling Break****

Short Stirrup Equitation Cross Rails- To be judged on position and overall ability and turnout. Riders must be 10 years old and under. Jumps will not exceed 1'9"

45. Over Fences (4 cross rails)

Beginner Equitation Cross Rails- Open to children or adults only who are in their first or second year of showing. To be judged on position and overall ability and turnout. *Only children will qualify for Colonials in this division. *

48. Over Fences (4 cross rails)

Long Stirrup Cross Rails- Open to children 11 years and older and adult amateurs on horses or ponies. To be judged 50% on equitation and 50% on horse. *Only adults will qualify for Colonials in this division. *

51. Over Fences (4 cross rails)

Mini Stirrup/Pre-Short Stirrup- Open to riders 10 years old and under. May cross enter into any other class where jumping is not permitted. *Only riders 8 years old and under may qualify for Colonials in this division. *

***In order to qualify for the 2019 Colonial Classic, you must first be a member of a participating Local Horse Show Series. You then will accumulate points from 1/1/2019-8/14/19. The top 3 riders from each division will be selected by their horse show series to show at the Colonial Classic. No separate membership is required.**

***All ages are as of December 1 of the**

receding year. Children are 17 years old and under.

*Beginner, Short and Long Stirrup rider's may not cross enter into any division at an above height.

RULES

1. A current Negative Coggins is required at the Secretaries Stand or must be on the Master Coggins List
2. Lake Equestrian Center Show committee, the volunteers, and NPHA will not be responsible for any loss or injury to any person, horse, or property incurred on any of the show grounds.
3. Riders must wear a SEI approved helmet while mounted on a horse anywhere on the grounds.
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to make any adjustments necessary to make the show run in a timely manner.
5. The entire division must be entered to be eligible for the Stake Class.
6. All ponies showing in Model and Children's Hunter must be measured by the NPHA Steward or hold a permanent NPHA or USEF measurement card.
7. All dogs must be leashed.
8. The show will run in accordance with current NPHA rules.
9. All Equine activities are pursuant to PA Equine Law Act 93 of 2005
10. No exhibitors, trainers nor spectators will be permitted to speak directly to a judge(s) without making arrangements with the steward
